

Sigma Lambda Beta Indiana Scholarship Fund Fact Sheet

- The Sigma Lambda Beta Indiana Scholarship Fund (ISF) was established in 2018 in cooperation with the Chicago Alumni Network as part of the We Can Achieve Foundation. Its' purpose is to provide financial support to aspiring young men attending universities with established chapters of Sigma Lambda Beta in the state of Indiana.
- The ISF leadership consists of five Board Members elected on an annual basis to serve the duration of one year.
- Through the We Can Achieve Foundation, the ISF created an endowment fund with an initial \$5,000 investment. All funds that raised by ISF Board Members go towards building the fund. Interest accrued from the account provides funding for scholarship awards on an annual basis.
- The ISF offers an annual Elite Scholar Award to aspiring young men that attend a qualifying university that includes Indiana University in Bloomington, Purdue University Northwest, and Purdue University in West Lafayette.
- The ISF has awarded two scholarship awards at \$500 each. Award recipients include the following:
 - Nicolas Martinez from Hammond, Indiana is attending Purdue University Northwest as a Business Marketing major with a minor in communications. Award received in Spring 2019
 - Oscar Lara from Hammond, Indiana is attending Purdue University Northwest as a Business Management major. Award received in Spring 2020
- As of January 2021, the endowment fund has surpassed \$22,000.
